A Maritime radio may only be operated by a holder of the appropriate certificate of competence or by someone under their direct personal supervision. This license is mandatory to advance onto further RYA course.

If anchored outside the breakwater at Barr Al Jissah Marina, AlHusan is one of the executive Hotel suites of the Barr Al Jissah chain of hotels. This area provides beautiful pristine beaches with privacy.

Approximately 7-9nm on the inlet of Ra's Al Khayran lies an ideal beach location. It's been stated that this location is relatively busy during the weekend which eliminates the necessity of private beaches. Mother ship will need to anchor outside the entrance to the Khor due to shallow waters on the inlet.

BANDER KHAYRAN, MUSCAT

Several dive sites are located within a series of coves and bays south-east of Muscat. The diving is predominantly on relatively shallow coral reefs, but the area also features a few drop-offs and one of the best wreck dives in Oman - the Al Munnassir.

The Oman government sunk this 84m./276ft. vessel as an artificial reef and she now lies upright on the bottom in about 30m./100ft. of water. Giant morays, large schools of snapper and goatfish as well as turtles and rays all now call the vessel home.

DAYMANIYAT ISLANDS, MUSCAT

This string of small, rocky islands north of Muscat are encircled by coral reefs and are a nature reserve and an important turtle nesting site. You'll be surrounded by abundant fish and glide over lush coral reefs down to 30m. / 100ft. It's not uncommon to see turtles, of course, but also rays & reef sharks.

FAHAL ISLANDS

Fahal Island is a fossilized limestone formation with three prominent pinnacles that peek out above sea level. It is also known as Shark Island. It is a large piece of land located 4 km offshore from Muscat's popular tourist beach. The easiest way to reach the island is by boat and it is an approximate ride of 20 minutes from the dive center.

The limestone that makes up the Island's composition was originally part of the sea floor and the island is made up of shells, coral and algae. It is not an island where one can picnic but it sure does make an interesting trip to see how the changes in the rock has affected its composition, and of course to see the sea life that it is made up of.

It is a fantastic place for divers of any level as it boasts different experiences at different depths. The bays contain varieties of soft and hard corals take are a perfect little exploration for novice divers and snorklers.

The journey continues into the Strait of Hormuz, with wonderful sea views of craggy headlands, distant islands and oil tankers plying up and down the strait, before turning in towards Kumzar itself, a colourful huddle of buildings wedged below sheer cliffs.

STRAITS OF HORMUZ

The name "Straits of Hormuz is well known to everybody abroad, but rarely anybody knows about the breathtaking beauty the region of Musandam. Its rocky land mass juts out into the "Strait of Hormuz", giving it great strategic importance over one of the busiest shipping lines in the world.

KHOR SHAM

Khor Sham is a spectacular sheltered 16 km long fjord with crystal clear water. The fjord with high mountains has given the area a second name "The Norway of Arabia"

NADIFI

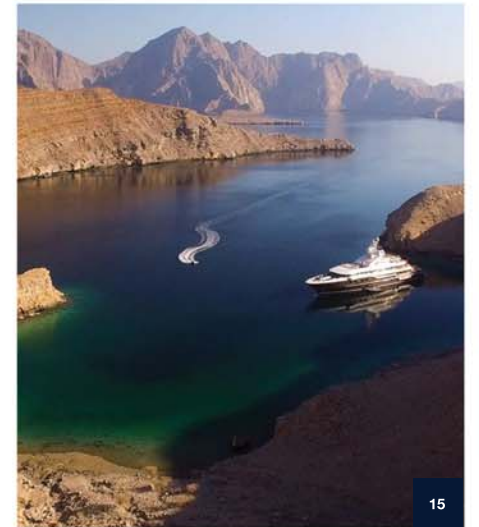
The first village of fjord with around 120-150 inhabitants. There is no land access to this area; most of the villagers are fisherman.

In 1984, the British built a telegraph station on the island. They laid an underwater cable from India to Basra in Iraq to get a telegraph connection between England and India. The island is surrounded by corals and reefs and is one of the best places for swimming and snorkeling.

SEEBI ISLAND

It's located at the end of the fjord and another ideal place for swimming and snorkeling in calm, crystal clear water.

In close vicinity is Lebanon Island which is part of the World Islands, great for beach access, relaxation and cocktails on the beach.

THE ART OF Shining Shoes

- Wipe off dust with a damp cloth.
- Use either a soft cotton cloth or a fine natural bristle brush, whose hairs are tightly packed to the handle, to put on the polish.
- Apply polish to shoe in a small circular movement (magic finger); wrap cloth around finger, or evenly cover shoe with polish using the brush. (The key is not to put too much polish on the shoe—but build the polish and shine up in thin layers—"Fat on Lean" process).
- Make sure that polish reaches the inside of the creases on the shoe (if they have any).

- Next let the polish "go off" on the shoe (preferably in the sun, or somewhere warm (heater) for 2 to 3 minutes. This will help the leather absorb the polish and also help the thin layer of polish melt (at a nano level) across the shoe.
- Using an atomizer, or pistol grip sprayer filled with water and adjusting the nozzle to a fine mist or spray, spray the entire shoe until it is covered with tiny droplets of water. Then, polish the shoe dry with the same bristle brush, or another one if you prefer.
- Repeat process 2 through 6 until you reach the level of shine you want or need.
- Always keep the polish damp or it will dry out and not take (water works better than spit, but in seriously dried out situations use white spirit, or mineral oil).
- After you have finished (you'll know when you can see your face in them), wipe with a cotton ball soaked in cold water, or lightly buff with a cotton cloth.
- You can run over the shoe with a silicone cloth at the end. However this will scratch the shoe leather at a microscopic level (synthetic cloth against a natural product) although it will supercharge your shine, it does not last more than 10 minutes. Use only in absolute emergencies.

11. When the shoes have dried up a little, using fine women's stockings evens the polish out and gives a further shine. You can add a little moisture by spraying or even by breathing on the shoe (there is quite a bit of moisture in human breath). If you don't believe the tip, try it.

12. Leave shoes in a cold room to dry. Best to place them in a shoe box with lid.



Who needs to use sunscreen?

In a word: everyone! The FDA (Food and Drug Administration) and the American Academy of Dermatology recognize six skin categories:

- I - Always burn easily, never tans, extremely sun sensitive skin Redheaded, and freckles, Irish/ Scots/Welsh
- II - Always burns easily, tans minimally, very sun sensitive skin Fair-skinned, fair haired, blue-eyed, Caucasians
- III - Sometimes burns, tans gradually to light brown, sun sensitive skin Average skin
- IV - Burns minimally, always tans to moderate brown, minimally sun sensitive Mediterranean-type Caucasians
- V - Rarely burns, tans well, sun insensitive skin Middle Eastern, some Hispanics, some African-Americans
- VI - Never burns, deeply pigmented, sun insensitive skin African-Americans

The American Academy of Dermatology suggests that, regardless of skin type, a sunscreen with an SPF of at least 15 should be used year-round.

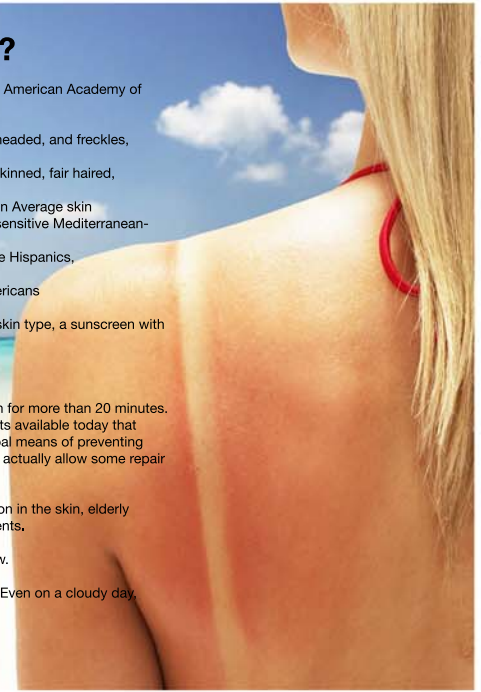
When should a sunscreen be used?

Sunscreens should be used every day if you are going to be in the sun for more than 20 minutes. They can be applied under makeup. There are many cosmetic products available today that contain sunscreens for daily use because sun protection is the principal means of preventing premature aging and skin cancer. Sunscreens used on a regular basis actually allow some repair of damaged skin.

However, because sun exposure is responsible for vitamin D production in the skin, elderly persons who use sunscreen regularly may require vitamin D supplements.

The sun's reflective powers are great -17% on sand and 80% on snow.

Don't reserve the use of these products only for sunny summer days. Even on a cloudy day, 80% of the sun's ultraviolet rays pass through the clouds.



Do's and Don'ts of staying crystal clean

Your crystal ware can add a sparkle to your table and can be handed down from generation to generation. However, great care should be taken to preserve its luster. "Be careful when cleaning because most crystal glasses are fine and can be easily damaged."

Do's

- Line the bottom of the sink with a clean dish towel before you start washing your crystal to minimize the risk of damaging it.
- Always hands wash crystal. You can use a soft sponge and a mild liquid soap for washing.
- Use a toothbrush, and vinegar or mild detergent, to clean the crevices of cut glass.
- Use a cleaning wand for tall glasses or vases.
- For a sparkling finish, rinse crystal in a solution of one part vinegar and three parts water. The vinegar will remove grease and water spots.
- Dissolve a teaspoon of baking powder in three cups of water and rinse the glasses to get rid of any odors. Crystals absorb odors, for instance from the cupboard where they are stored and baking powder banishes odour.
- Use only warm water to wash and rinse because sudden changes in temperature can cause cracking and clouding.
- Dry gently, using gloves when drying crystal to avoid fingerprints.

Don'ts

- Wash your crystal in a dishwasher as it can be easily damaged.
- Crowd crystal pieces together in the sink or in the rack for drying.
- Store your crystal upside down as it can put stress on the rim, which is very delicate.
- Never use any abrasive material to wash or dry crystal.
