

# 1 The Maldives Victory Wreck

Is perhaps the most popular wreck dive in the atoll. The wreck sits at a depth of about 35 meters and since it sank in 1981, it has been encrusted with an amazing array of colorful corals.

Groupers, fusiliers and batfish are among its residents.



# 2 Ari Atoll is famous for its pelagics

North Male' Atoll offers some parallels. Located in the southeast of the atoll, Manta Point is famous for its mantas which gather at the site to feed during the southwest monsoon from May to October.

The reef offers a colorful array of corals and a variety of marine life.



# 4 Connecting with whale Sharks

One of the most jaw-dropping experiences one can have in the Maldives is to swim, snorkel, or dive alongside a whale shark - arguably one of the most majestic creatures in the ocean. Whale sharks (Rhincodon Typus) are the largest shark, and in fact the largest fish alive today.

breathtaking sights are fascinating to say the least.



Coincidentally, The Maldives Whale Shark Research Programme, a research-based conservation charity dedicated to studying whale sharks and fostering community- focused conservation initiatives, is also based here.

Hanifaru Bay in Baa Atoll is a feeding hotspot for manta rays. The best time to visit Hanifaru Bay is between June and early October. Scuba diving is no longer permitted here but you can always go swimming or snorkeling amidst these gentle giants and get up close and personal with whale sharks.

**Addu Atoll** is an exceptional scuba diving spot where you can spot almost everything from manta rays to eagle rays to turtles and more.

In **North Male' Atoll,** Meeru Island Resort & Spa's **Turtle Reef,** is one of the best locations to spot turtles.


### **RASDHOO ATOLL**

Rasdhoo Atoll is made up of five islands, Veligandu, Madivarufinolhu, Madivaru, Rasdhoo and Kuramathi (the tlargest inhabited island in the archipelago), which lie to the east and south. The western part is exclusively made up of large reefs, with an unusual formation of double crested reefs. Both Kuramathi Kandu and Rasdhoo Kandu passes are found on either coast of the main island. Rasdhoo Atoll is a very popular destination for diving. Madivaru Island is even famous for being the best shark watching site in all of the Maldives

Outer reef falling to a depth of 200m, with one of the best visibility of the archipelago, the underwater world of Madivaru is spectacular. 




